This year, we were thrilled to host Joel Vaughn in concert in Fort Frances, Ontario, and to be part of church mission conferences in Embarrass and Warroad, Minn. We look forward to seeing more of you at community events in the months ahead!

We also said goodbye to two staff—Greg, our morning show host, and Shawna from our office. We’re thankful for their service, and we hope to introduce new team members this fall.

In May, our translator in Virginia (95.3 FM) went off the air after someone cut and took the antenna feed line. Repairs could be costly.
